Directions to Marion K. Salomon & Associates:

From the East: West on LIE to exit 48/ROUND SWAMP RD/OLD BETHPAGE/FARMINGDALE onto N SERVICE RD - go 0.3 mi. Turn Left on ROUND SWAMP RD - go 0.3 mi. Bear Right on OLD COUNTRY RD - go 0.5 mi. Turn Right on E BETHPAGE RD - go 0.3 mi. Arrive at 125 E. BETHPAGE ROAD, PLAINVIEW.

From the West: East on LIE to exit 48/ROUND SWAMP RD/OLD BETHPAGE onto S SERVICE RD - go 0.3 mi. Turn Right on ROUND SWAMP RD - go 0.2 mi. Bear Right on OLD COUNTRY RD - go 0.5 mi. Turn Right on E BETHPAGE RD - go 0.3 mi. Arrive at 125 E. BETHPAGE ROAD, PLAINVIEW.
